Deli Farm Run:

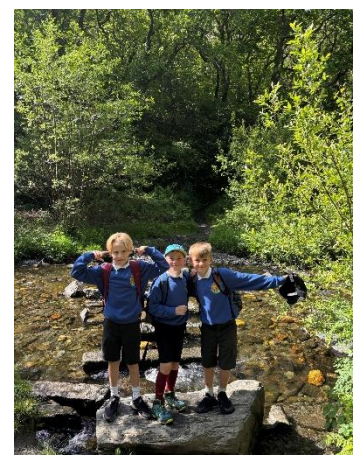
