Curriculum

This half term, our new value is **JUSTICE** and our Enquiry question across the school is, '**Who holds the power?**'. There are some great enquiries in every class and the children have been delving deep into what life was like in the past at different times in history.

Class 1 will be learning about heroes from the past – focussing on Grace Darling and her heroic rescue at sea. Class 2 will be focussing on the life of a Victorian child, who held the power at this time? Class 3 will be extending their historical knowledge by exploring another ancient civilisation – Ancient Greece. Whilst Class 4 delve into learning about power through the construction of the Berlin Wall and what this time was like for the people living there.

Time2Move Easter Holiday Club


