Dear Parents/Carers,

Staffing:

Reports:

Children from Saplings to Year 5 will be bringing home their school report today. You will also be given a printout of your child's attendance and our term dates for next year. For your information, by the end of the year, attendance should fall no lower than 95%. You can use the Arbor app to track this. Year 6 children will be on their transition days and so their reports will go out on Tuesday 8th July as this is when we have access to their SATs results so we can send these home in the same envelope.

Uniform:

Our second-hand uniform will be available in the last week of term if there are any items you are looking for. We have been through our lost property bucket and returned anything with names on. In September, please do ensure that all items of uniform are named, this makes it much easier to return items to the correct owner. This is with a view to starting a weekly after school club from September. Please ensure your child has their PE kit and trainers in school for these days to enable them to take part.
