Dear Parents and Carers

With only a few days remaining of this first part of the Spring Term, we wanted to share some updates with you that will be useful for the next few weeks.

Website

We have been working hard to ensure that all the information that you need, including any relevant policies, are on the website available for you. Over the coming weeks, we will be adding additional documents linked to curriculum so you can see how the children's learning progresses as they move through the school. Ms Thorpe, who heads up our wellbeing team, has put together a new tab for you linked to

wellbeing and things that will help you at home. These are linked to areas such as helping your child to sleep, toileting as well as some mindful activities you can take part in with your child. Our aim is to help empower you and point you in the direction of support should you need it. We hope you find them useful. If our wellbeing team can help you, your child or your family in any way, please do come and talk to us. We are fortunate to have Tracey Weller (Educational Mental Health Practitioner from the NHS) working with our team one day a week to support children and families. Wellbeing is held in focus at our school and we can work with you for the needs of your child.

<u>Attendance</u>

Thank you for supporting us in getting your child to school every day. We have seen an increase with many children attending more regularly which boosts their confidence and helps them to belong and feel part of our tribe. We have received more holiday request forms in recent weeks and we do encourage you to consider the most appropriate times to take your child out of school.

Please remember that we are unable to authorise any holiday requests unless under exceptional circumstances. Please come and speak to us if you have any concerns linked to your child's attendance. In order to find out how many sessions your child has missed, do log into your Arbor app.



On Thursday 9th February, the Pupil Leadership Team have decided to organise a non-school uniform day to help us raise funds towards a new shelter for our playground. The recommended donation is £1 if you would like to support us on this day.

In addition, there will be a cake sale after school in the car park on **Tuesday 7th February**. We would be very

<u>Wraparound</u>

You may be aware that our numbers have dropped for our wraparound sessions, and on many occasions, it has not been financially viable to open the session. For the time being, we will not be offering Breakfast Club on Monday and Friday mornings or after school on Tuesdays. However, if you do require these sessions, please do get in touch, if we receive more than one request for a particular slot, we can look into opening it up on an ad hoc basis.

<u>PE Kits</u>

Can parents please ensure that children have a PE kit in school. We still have a number of children who do not have a change of clothes for PE sessions. This means they are taking part in shoes that are not appropriate or trousers/skirts that are not suitable for the activities they are completing. PE is a statutory part of the curriculum and children do need the correct kit to be able to access it effectively. If there are issues around kit, please do speak to us so we can help.



Second Hand Uniform

Just a reminder that our second-hand uniform will be available for purchase from **Monday 6th February** in the entrance foyer. We have plenty of stock in various sizes so please come and replenish your stocks if you need additional supplies. We do have second hand PE kit available too.

<u>Milk</u>

Our school provides a milk scheme that is available to all of our pupils and we would like to invite you to register your child. School milk is free for under-5s, and for over-5s it is available at a subsidised price of 28p per day. If you would like your child to receive milk on a daily basis, please register and pay on the Cool Milk website <u>Cool Milk - the UK's</u> leading school and nursery milk supplier,

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If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, Tintagel Primary will be providing a free 189ml portion of low-fat milk in conjunction with the Department of Education's School Food Plan. For your child to receive this, the form on the link below will need to be completed by **Friday 3rd February** <u>Cool Milk FSM</u>.

Water Bottles

Please ensure that no glass water bottles are brought into school, we do have a limited amount of school water bottles that can be purchased via ParentPay. Just a polite reminder that they should be filled with water only please.
