Clubs:

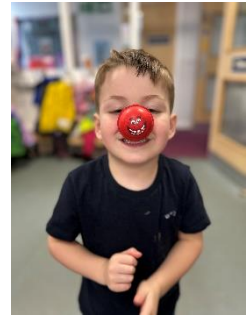
We will have a brand new clubs list available for you to sign up to when we return after the Easter break. Booster sessions will continue as usual when we return.
