Class 1: (Year 1 only due to Reception parents having the 'Cheese and Wine' evening recently for key information) Monday 11th September at 3pm


Class 2: Thursday 14th September at 3pm

School Dinner and Snacks

Just a reminder that children from Reception to Year 2 are eligible for a universal free school meal every day. There is a wide range of options on the menu to suit all tastes – so do make the most of this offer. If your child has moved into Year 3 and above, you do need to pay for school meals on Parent Pay please. All children in Class 1 and 2 also receive a free piece of fruit every day, however, children in Class 3 and 4 are welcome to bring in a healthy snack to get them through until lunchtime.

Wraparound

Our wraparound child care club is continuing this year. Breakfast Club starts from 8am and after school club runs until 5pm. We continue to review this service and the timings so please do give us some feedback and as long as there is a need, we will try and accommodate families as



much as we can. Please book and pay for this through ParentPay rather than contacting the office to book this for you. At present, this service isn't available to Nursery children. If you have any queries, please contact the office for more information.

As ever, it will be a busy term – where we hope your children will feel happy and comfortable in their classes. If you have any worries or concerns, always come and speak to us – there is always something we can do to help.
