Can parents please ensure that children have a PE kit in school. We still have a number of children who do not have a change of clothes for PE sessions. This means they are taking part in shoes that are not appropriate or trousers/skirts that are not suitable for the activities they are completing. PE is a statutory part of the curriculum and children do need the correct kit to be able to access it effectively. If there are issues around kit, please do speak to us so we can help.



Second Hand Uniform:

Just a reminder that we have a large selection of second hand uniform available next week in the entrance foyer. We have plenty of sizes available so please come and replenish your stocks if you need additional supplies. We do have second hand PE kit available too.

<u>Sustainability – A message from the Trust:</u>

"Sustainability is the idea of meeting the needs of the present without harming the ability of future generations to meet their needs. It's about maintaining a balance between people and the planet."

So, as part of Aspire Academy Trusts' Sustainability programme, our 2025 focus is **Energy Waste** in our schools. We are working with **Energy Sparks** which is a charity that offers a unique school-specific energy management tool and education programme.



Through awareness and education, we aim to lower our carbon footprint and reduce school energy bills. Across the trust we will set our energy reduction target to 5% for electricity and 10% for gas. And to do this we encourage the whole community, pupils, staff, site teams, caterers, cleaners, governor, parents, family and friends to get involved and become 'Agents of Change'.

In school, we will be running in a 'Get Energised' initiative, with our pupils taking the lead, looking at energy usage, where we can save energy and get into good energy saving habits - like turning the lights off when a room is not in use. See the poster attached. And we don't want to stop there - here are some activities for pupils and their families to do at home. See 5 Day Energy Powerdown Challenge and Be an Energy Detective. All activities completed will not only help reduce energy wastage but gain points for the school in a bid to win prices - such as £1000! We can't wait to see what a difference we can all make $\[\]$
